Monday 18/5/20

Morning Session English


- *Choose your new book. Look at the cover and the title and make predictions about the book.
- *Read your book aloud. Stop if you get to any words you don't know the meaning of. Ask a family member to tell you or help you find the meaning.
- *Write your new spelling words and say them out loud as you write. After they are written, spell each word while you clap each letter.
- *Write a recount about something you have done (perhaps your first day back at school).
- *You will need "Who", "When" and "Where" as well as time connectives and adjectives.
- *Remember, saying your sentences out loud will help you know where to put the full stops.
- *Try not to start every sentence with "Then".

Middle Session Mathematics

Odd and Even Numbers

- *In your book draw 2 large circles. Write even and odd above each circle.
- *Close your eyes and choose a number card. Is it odd or even?

Write it in the correct circle.



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- *Do this several times. Your circles will become full of numbers.
- **★**Choose 2 cards to make a two digit number.

Is it odd or even? Remember if the last digit is even then the whole number is even. If the second digit is odd then the whole number is odd.

- *Write the two-digit number in the correct circle.
- *Do this several times.

Afternoon Session STEM

Build a bridge

- **★**Your bridge must be at least 60 cm long.
- *It must stand at least 10cm off the ground.
- *Your bridge must be strong enough to hold the weight of 4 pencils or textas.
- *The cross part of your bridge can only be made of paper. You can use other materials for other parts of your bridge.
- *If your bridge doesn't work, try different things and take notice of what is working best.
- *Do you think you would get a different result if you were able to use different materials??

What did you discover? Did the materials make a difference?



Read it out loud and try to hear where each sentence should finish. Use a coloured pencil to put the full stops and capital letters in the correct places.


