<p><u>*Sight word task</u>                      Practise writing set ONE of your blue sight words three times</p> <p>* Watch the uploaded video of 'King Pig'. Verbally describe one of the characters – What do they look like? What do they do? What do they like/dislike? Upload a video of you explaining this onto <u>Class Dojo!</u></p> <p>* Cut out pictures of people from magazines and create speech bubbles, think about what the people might be saying.</p>	<p>* Draw 5 squares or rectangles and colour them in. When you are finished fold and cut them in half making 2 equal parts.</p> <p>*Rainbow numbers: write numbers 1 – 30 (or more if you can) using 3 different colours</p> <p><b>B R E A K</b></p> <p>*Collect 20 things from around the house and put them into groups of 2.</p>	<p>* What is Recycling? <p>*<u>Sight word task</u> Look, cover, write, check</p> <p>*Watch the uploaded video of 'King Pig'. Choose 5 adjectives (describing words) to describe the setting in a story.</p> <p>*Create a birthday card for your favourite character in the story. <u>Share this on Class Dojo!</u></p> <p>* Read and colour the words that start with 'e' - In your scrapbook, draw and label <u>5</u> things that start with the 'e' sound.</p>	<p>* Roll two dice and say the <u>bigger</u> number as fast as you can. See if you can turn this into a game with someone in your family. Who can say it the fastest?</p> <p><b>B R E A K</b></p> <p>*Count backwards from 12 and then from 20 if you can! Use your number chart if you need help.</p> <p>*Go for a walk and collect 5 sticks. When you get back, order them from tallest to shortest. <u>Share on Class Dojo!</u></p>	<p>* Look at old baby photos of yourself and talk about what you could and couldn't do at that age. Compare with a photo of you now.</p> <p>Extension – Parent/carer to do the same and discuss differences.</p> <p><b>B R E A K</b></p>

<p>*<u>Sight word task</u> Find set ONE of your blue sight words in a magazine and stick them into your scrapbook. <u>Share on Class Dojo!</u></p> <p>*Watch the uploaded video of 'King Pig'. Think about the moral of the story and discuss this with a family member. How can you show kindness to someone? Draw a picture to share your thoughts.</p> <p>*Do a short presentation (or create a video) of you discussing your culture. You can talk about the different foods you eat, celebrations, and any traditional clothing or activities.</p>	<p>* Practise counting forwards and backwards with a parent/carer from 1 – 10 and then from 1 – 20.</p> <p>*Measure the height of two of your favourite toys using toothpicks. Which one is longer or taller?</p> <p>*Using a deck of cards, flip two cards and identify which number is bigger and which is smaller.</p>	<p>* Choose your favourite toy and talk to an adult about what it is made of. Talk about why toys aren't made of certain materials such as paper or glass.</p> <p>Compare the material of your favourite toy with the material of a parent/carers chosen object.</p>

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## Thursday 21.05.2020

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<p><i>*Sight word task</i> Use a magnifying glass or your pointer to find this week's words in a book.</p> <p>Watch the uploaded video of 'King Pig'. Tell your parent/carer about the story. What happens? Why would you recommend/not recommend this story to your friends?</p> <p>Would you rather eat pizza or ice cream? Why? Draw/write down your thoughts.</p> <p>* Read and colour the words that start with 'p' - In your scrapbook, draw and label <u>5</u> things that start with the 'p' sound.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>B R E A K</b></p> <p><i>* Create a number line at home, using chalk outside, or inside with paper. Stand on a number and give the number before and after. Start with 1-10 then 1-20.</i></p> <p><i>*Find a collection of objects in your house and share them between yourself and one family member equally.</i></p> <p><i>*Find objects in your house that are bigger than you. Find objects in your house that are smaller than you.</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>B R E A K</b></p> <p><i>*Choose your favourite picture from a book and recreate it by drawing, painting or collage.</i></p>

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## Friday 22.05.2020

### Morning Session English

*\*Sight word task*

See if you can read all your new blue sight words without help!

\* Watch the uploaded video of 'King Pig'. Using your clothes or any dress up items you have at home, dress up as your favourite story book character and retell the story to your family.

\* Draw/write one exciting thing that you did this week. Share this on Class Dojo!

\*How many words can you think of that rhyme with "\_en"? Write/draw as many as you can.

### Middle Session Mathematics

\*Read number cards (from the student pack). Put the numbers in order forwards and in order backwards. Try to say the numbers out of order!

\* Use a pen, pencil, block or paddle pop sticks to measure your favourite toys. Order them from shortest to tallest.

\*Find all the books in your house and arrange them from biggest to smallest – the exact same way we do this in the bookshelf of our classroom library.

### Afternoon Session

\* Draw or if available use magazines or shopping catalogues to sort healthy and unhealthy foods.

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
