COVID Safe End of Year Celebrations

Due to the pandemic some of the ways we usually celebrate the end of the year will need to be different. Current NSW Health and Department of Education COVID-19 guidelines restrict government schools from having large gatherings of parents or community members on school sites. At present, government schools are not allowed to host gatherings of more than 20 people indoors or 30 people outdoors. Theses total numbers include parents/carers, staff and students. Unfortunately these limited numbers mean that we will not be able to have our parents/carers or community members at our 2020 Presentation Assembly or our Year 2 Farewell celebrations or our Preschool graduations. I am deeply sorry about this situation, but I am sure you understand the importance of us in following Department of Education directives and for all of us to keep the health of our school community as a priority during these unpredictable times in a pandemic.

We will endeavour to make short videos of the children receiving awards and/or graduation certificates and relay them to you via Class Dojo (or on the SeeSaw app for our preschool parents).
