All students from Preschool to Year 2 will be involved in school photographs on Wednesday 28 October. Whole school, class and individual photos will be taken by visiting professional photographers. Information about the costing of photos will be distributed after the school holidays. If you would like to order any photographs, please complete the order form on the envelope which will be distributed as soon as we return from the spring school holidays, enclose the exact payment required and return to your child's class teacher by Wednesday 28 October. If you would like to order a family photo for siblings who attend Sefton Infants School and Preschool, please visit the school office to obtain a special order form.

It is vital that <u>all</u> K-2 students wear <u>full summer uniform</u> on the day of the photographs. This full uniform includes a red short-sleeved polo shirt, navy blue shorts or culottes (for girls), navy blue socks and black school shoes. Many families, as well as the school, purchase photos and want the photos and the school to be represented at its best. Therefore, it is very important for students to be extra neat and tidy in their school uniform on the day. There will <u>not</u> be any gymnastics lessons on this day. Thank you for your support.

Social Media and Child Safety

Book Character Parade - Term 4


