At Sefton Infants School we encourage all students to take responsibility for their own belongings and to be independent in packing and unpacking their school items. We also remind our families that students are **not allowed** to bring any toys or personal items that are not needed at school. The school has many sport and recreational items that the children can play with in the classroom and playground. It is safer for children to keep their precious toys, sport items and personal equipment at home. Thank you for your support.

### **COVID-19 Term 1 update for Schools**

Sefton Infants School is continuing to follow the NSW Department of Education COVID-19 restrictions and guidelines in line with advice from NSW Health. The current restrictions are important precautionary measures to help ensure our school remains a safe place for teaching and learning. We thank our parents and school community for cooperating with these COVID guidelines:

- Students must not attend if they are unwell and/or present with mild symptoms. Students must return a negative COVID-19 test and be symptom free prior to returning to school.
- Parents and carers must continue to drop off and collect their children from the school gates, following social distancing practices.
- Parents and carers can only enter the school to attend a planned student welfare meeting with the class teachers/principal or for enrolment purposes.
- All parent/carers visiting the school site for a meeting need to follow COVID safe check-in procedures and maintain physical distancing.
  - Parents and Friends (P&F) Association meetings need to take place after school hours with restrictions. Gatherings at school are limited to 30 people indoors.
