#### Just like you

This Friday 17 November, our students will be participating in a worthwhile workshop called 'Just Like You' delivered at our school by trained facilitators from Variety - the Children's Charity. 'Just Like You' is a disability awareness program designed to build understanding, acceptance and inclusion. Through celebrating differences, developing empathy and creating inclusion, students learn that people with a disability are the same as everyone else – they are 'Just Like You'. The workshop content is lively, interactive and compelling, encouraging the students to reflect on their own roles and actions as a citizen in their school and community. Some key concepts covered in the K-2 program include:

- Understanding and including people with disabilities
- We may have differences but our physical and emotional needs are the same
- Uniqueness and differences are positive

The workshop content and activities are aligned with the Australian curriculum and NSW syllabuses for Health and Personal Development, as well as English by understanding that people may use different systems to communicate with others.

Sefton Infants School supports the values of the Just Like You program. We want to make a positive difference in the lives of children living with a disability and help ALL children reach their full potential regardless of ability or background. We are looking forward to participating in this valuable program and we encourage our families to discuss the Just Like You workshop experience with their children.

Mrs De Angelis's Inquiry Learning group have been very busy trying to resolve an issue they have observed at Sefton Infants School. The students noticed that there has been an increasing number of items in the Lost Property Box, particularly hats, jumpers and lunch boxes or bottles. This fine group of students have been collecting data and collaborating to plan and execute some motivating problem solving ideas to get the Sefton Infants School Lost Property Box to zero items, including their slogan of 'Zero L.Pro'. They have been investigating the larger impact of lost property on the environment and sustainability. The group have followed Science processes to plan and trial information and communication ideas, as well positive whole school actions to reduce the wastage created by lost property and the money spent by parents/carers on replacing item.

One of the first proactive initiatives the student group has taken is a 'Naming Day' where all student items at school with no names were labelled with their owner's name. We are hoping this will help items be returned to the students. The group have more problem solving ideas in the planning to tackle this issue. We will keep you updated as the student team and Mrs De Angelis measure and track the lost property data. How can you help us get 'Zero L.Pro'?


